PLEASE READ THIS ORDER CAREFULLY

UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF BY-LAW NO. 2020-03-26-01 OF THE SERPENT RIVER FIRST NATION BAND COUNCIL, A BY-LAW RESPECTING COVID-19 VIRUS (the "COVID-19 BY-LAW"), THE COUNCIL OF SERPENT RIVER FIRST NATION, ON THE ADVICE OF THE INCIDENT COMMANDER OF THE SERPENT RIVER FIRST NATION ("HEALTH OFFICER") ORDERS:

ORDER NO. 2020-03-26-002

WHEREAS Serpent River First Nation passed By-Law No. 2020-03-26-01 indexed as the *Serpent River First Nation COVID-19 BY-LAW*;

WHEREAS Section 9(b) direct, authorize, or delegate to the Chief or designate the ability to take actions, and make such orders as the Chief and Council or designate considers necessary and not contrary to law in respect of the matters set out in section 12, after seeking and considering advice from staff employed by Council, members of Council, public health officials or as may otherwise be deemed appropriate,

WHEREAS local governments in Ontario have enacted social distancing measures to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus;

WHEREAS Serpent River First Nation enacted Order No. 2020-03-26-01 (Shelter-in-Place Order) for the protection of the community, which included restrictions on travel onto the Reserve except for limited purposes;

WHEREAS it is desirable to lift restrictions on travel onto the Reserve set out in sections 5 of Order No. 2020-03-26-01; while observing social distancing restrictions, following all current Public Health Guidelines, and monitoring community health;

AND THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT:

Short form of reference

1. This Order may be cited as the "Specific Order Lifting Travel Restrictions" and shall be deemed to be an Order for all purposes and within the meaning of the Serpent River First Nation COVID-19 Virus By-Law

Suspension of travel restrictions

2. The operation of sections 5 (Limitation on travel) of Order No. 2020-03-26-001 is hereby suspended.


Preventive measures remain in force

3. For greater certainty, nothing in section 2 of this Order modified the other provisions of Order No. 2020-03-26-001, including sections 4 (Limitations on gatherings), sections 6 (Curfew), self-isolation and social distancing.
