To participate, you must have an account with OneFeather and you **MUST** have an email address.

Who Can Vote?

- **This vote is open to all registered 201 Serpent River First Nation members OVER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS OLD. Participating in this vote does NOT mean eligibility to vote in elections as per Serpent River First Nation Membership Code.**
- **To participate, you must have an account with OneFeather and you MUST have an email address.**
