Position Summary:

The Health Educator will work collaboratively to engage children, youth, adults of all ages, and elders in the promotion of physical, mental, emotional and spiritual wellness, protection of health and prevention of illness and injury through the facilitation and/or coordination of a range of evidence-based primary and secondary health prevention and intervention programs and strategies to address risk and protective factors to promote healthy lifestyle choices and help individuals assume greater control of personal health and social wellbeing in order to reduce the incidence of disease.

Position Duties

- Design health promotion initiatives and educational resources, coordinate and implement educational seminars, workshop sessions and community activities.
- Facilitate the integration of health education and promotion into community-based initiatives.
- Design, implement and evaluate community-based diabetes education activities that promote healthy lifestyle choices.
- Collaborate and work closely with local and regional health staff on the development and implementation of diabetes education programming.
- Collaborate with the interdisciplinary health team: to plan and implement and evaluate patient care in consultation with clients and their families.
- Collaborate with leadership, staff, partners and community in achieving the goals and objectives identified in the Serpent River First Nation Community Health Plan, Comprehensive Community Plan and other Community Development initiatives.
