Summer Student Lead

As a Summer Student Lead, your role will involve planning and overseeing activities for children and teenagers during their summer break. You will be responsible for creating a work plan, organizing schedules, and ensuring the safety and enjoyment of all participants. Strong leadership and organizational skills are essential for this position.

DUTIES:

- Collaborate with the Summer Student Lead and other SRFN departments or organizations to develop programming and special events
- Develop and implement camp programs, schedules, and daily activities that promote fun, learning, and cultural engagement
- Attend and support day trips/camp during the months of July and August outside of SRFN (ie. Daystar, Sudbury Trips, etc.)
- Supervise camp staff and provide guidance, direction, and support as needed
- Ensure compliance with health and safety regulations and emergency procedures and SRFN Policies
- Communicate regularly with parents/ guardians to provide updates and address concerns
- Coordinate transportation and logistics for campers and staff
- Plan and oversee special events and theme days and community based activities
- Maintain accurate records including registrations forms, attendance and incident reports
- Keep accurate records (registration forms, incident reports, attendance numbers)
- Stay in regular contact and notify the Employment & Training Coordinator/Director of Education of any issues or conflicts promptly.
